

What is SCORE

SCORE is a 3-year European project which will bring an innovative intervention in the framework of education of professionals in working with refugees & asylum seekers, in areas except the first entrance and hot spot areas.

This kind of professionals could be service commissioners and providers working in local authorities in children's and adults' services, who would benefit from receiving specific training and support by VET teachers & trainers. It will also be of interest to asylum seeker & refugee organizations and voluntary organizations in these areas. The project will also help educate the local societies on the refugee humanitarian problem.

The project started on September 2017 and ends on August 2020.

SCORE's Aims

To provide a new type of education to community and health workers, in the field of effective contact with refugees, and to any other volunteers.

To bring to the participants a greater understanding and responsiveness for the vulnerable groups, such as refugees

To encourage these professionals have a more active participation in society, for refugees

To promote to the participants a more positive attitude towards the EU values

To raise awareness in local communities about refugees

Joint Staff Training



On 28th of June 2018 was completed the Joint Staff Training of SCORE Project, which was held in **Perugia (Italy)**. The training lasted 3 days (26-27-28/06/2018) and **was attended by executives of project partners**, from Greece (University of Patras & p-consulting), Denmark (SOSU Oestjylland), Italy (ARCI Perugia & Forma. Azione) and Spain (Centro San Viator).

During the training participants discussed issues related to the provision of specialized services to refugees and migrants, as well as the problems refugees and migrants are facing during their residence in the host country and how these problems can be addressed by health professionals and community workers.

In addition, specific techniques were presented for the training of health professionals and community workers, aiming to acquire the knowledge and skills they need, in order to provide quality services to migrants and refugees. At the same time, participants were trained in mentoring & coaching techniques.

Important issues have also been discussed, regarding the legislation for migration and refugees in each country and the actions taken to address these issues.

Also, during the training, the participants visited the home of 7 refugees from Africa, who have

applied for asylum in Italy and they are waiting for the final decision. The visit was very important, as project partners had the opportunity to discuss with refugees the problems they experienced in their journey to Italy, the difficulties they are facing and what they do in order to integrate to the local community (e.g. learn Italian language, vocational training for finding a job, etc.)



Finally, participants discussed about the training program which is going to be created by all partners of the project and the modules which will be developed.

Project 2nd Meeting



The 2nd Meeting of SCORE project was held in **Bilbao, Spain on 8th and 9th of October 2018**.

The main **objectives** of the meeting were to:

- Finalise the Training Course for the teachers/trainers who are going to train the community workers and health professionals.

- Finalise the modules of the E-learning Courses for community workers and health professionals & the length of the Courses.
- Design the E-learning Platform, which will be created during the following months
- Discuss about the learning material which will be used for the training courses

Partners also discussed the next steps for the implementation of the project and arranged the **3rd project meeting** which will be held in **Aarhus** (Denmark) by **SOSU Oestjylland** on **04th & 5th of June 2019**.



Round Table at EFVET's 27th International Conference 2018

SCORE project was presented to the 27th International Conference of EFVET, which took place in Lake Como (Italy) **24th to 27th of October 2018**.



EfVET is one of the leading European-wide professional associations which has been created by, and for, Vocational Education and Training (VET) providers.

Representatives from p-consulting, Centro San Viator, Forma.Azione, Arci and Sosu Oestjylland (project partners) attended to the Conference and

discussed with the delegates the aims and objectives of SCORE project.

Moreover, a **round table** was organised where participants discussed with project partners and asked questions about the training course which is going to be created during the next months.

Training of trainers

Until the **end of December 2018** all partners will organise the training course **for trainers**, who are going to implement the E-learning Courses for community workers and health professionals.



The structure of the Training Course has already been finalised and during November 2018 partners will start the **recruitment** of the professionals who are going to train the participants to the E-learning Courses.

Trainers are expected to be lawyers, social workers, doctors, sociologists, psychologists and other professionals.

The training of trainers will take place in all partners' countries (Greece, Italy, Spain and Denmark) and will last 3 days.
