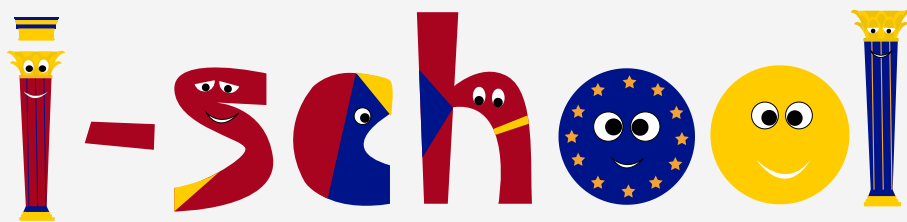

### Keep the Cultural Heritage alive!

Europe's cultural heritage is a rich mosaic of cultural and creative expression, including natural areas, monuments, art, and traditions, enriching citizens' lives and strengthening social capital. A 2017 Eurobarometer survey revealed that 88% of Europeans believe that cultural heritage should be included in school curricula.

Our project, i-SCHOOL, aims to strengthen students' connection with European Cultural Heritage. This will be achieved by integrating its teaching into everyday school life through the use of innovative digital tools and educational methods. In this way, it will enhance students' interest in engaging with cultural heritage issues.

# We are developing the project deliverables

The partners are working on the development of the project's deliverables, the innovative tools that will enhance the integration of cultural heritage teaching in schools.

- **Online Course for primary and secondary school teachers**

The online educational program aims to strengthen the knowledge and skills of teachers to integrate cultural heritage teaching into the educational process. It will include 11 Modules, 28 Topics, and 11 quizzes, and upon successful completion, the teacher will receive a certificate of attendance.

- **Cultural Heritage Toolkit**

A complementary tool to the online educational program. It consists of a series of lesson plans related to cultural heritage and education, to be developed in collaboration with cultural institutions. These interactive lessons will be ready for implementation by teachers.



- **E-Learning Platform**

The online platform will host the online educational program for teachers and will be accompanied by a User Manual for the proper use of its environment.

- **Digital Game "H-Guardians"**

An engaging tool for students to explore various virtual cultural routes. Routes will be created for two age groups, 10-12 years and 13-15 years, and will be based on a mission system. Upon completing each mission, the next module will become available, allowing students to learn more about European cultural heritage in a fun and creative way.
