

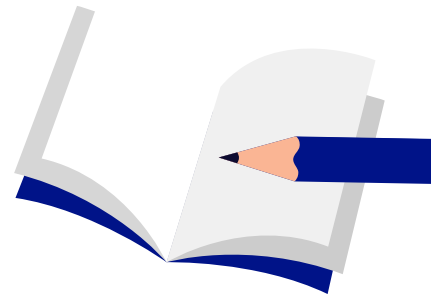

i-SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL TOOLS ARE READY!

i-SCHOOL has developed interactive digital educational tools based on innovative teaching methods. They are aimed at both teachers and students, aiming to empower educators to integrate the teaching of cultural heritage into everyday teaching and captivate the interest of students.



The tools developed are as follows:

► Online course for primary and secondary school teachers

This educational program aims to enhance the knowledge and skills of teachers to incorporate lessons on cultural heritage into their daily teaching schedule. It includes 11 modules, 28 topics, and 11 quizzes. Upon successful completion, the teacher receives a certificate of attendance.

A complementary tool to the educational program, consisting of a series of interactive lesson plans ready to be used in the classroom. Developed in collaboration with cultural institutions, following the methodology of non-formal education and the use of digital tools. They aim to be used by teachers of various specialties as supplementary material for teaching different cultural elements in a pleasant and creative way for children.

Cultural Heritage Toolkit

► Digital Game "H-Guardians"

The game presents elements of the cultural heritage of the participating countries in a fun way. It is aimed at students and includes twelve virtual cultural routes, six for the age group 10-12 years and six for 13-15 years.

The 4th Transnational Meeting of the i-SCHOOL partners was successfully held. This was the last face-to-face meeting of the project, where the partners traveled to Larnaca, Cyprus, on May 9-10.

The discussion was dominated by the digital educational tools developed during the project. As we were in the final stage of delivering them, the partners analyzed the results of the final tests conducted in our countries and highlighted minor improvements for their optimal functionality.

We also reviewed the project, with the goals and milestones achieved, and set deadlines for those remaining, emphasizing the Multiplier Events to be held by each partner in their country.

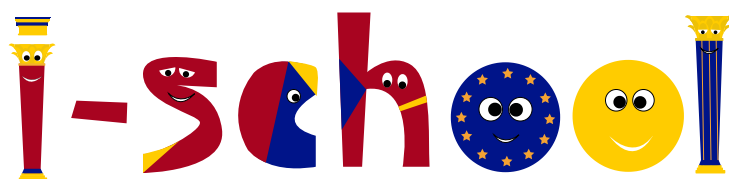
