ONGOING ACTIVITIES

Project Deliverables

The project partners are working on the 2nd deliverable of the project, the [Digital Educational Games](#). We have finalized the game scenarios for the topics "Stereotypes" and "Sexual Health" too, and we are moving forward with the development of the games for these too. Simultaneously, we are preparing the introductory texts that will accompany the games on the online platform. Additionally, we are advancing the delivery of the 3rd tool to be implemented by the project, the [Online Training Program in health promotion and health education through DGBL](#), aimed at primary school teachers and principals. We are working on the development of the training material and the e-learning platform to proceed with the pilot testing phase.

NEXT STEPS

September

- Development of the Educational Games and the Training Program in English
- Internal testing of the two deliverables by all partners
- Finalization of the games and the educational program after internal testing
- Translation of the games into the partners' languages

October-December

- Translation of the educational program into all languages
- Internal testing of the deliverables in all languages
- Finalization of the deliverables after internal testing
- Pilot testing of the games by students and the educational program by teachers in all partner countries

We met in Romania from April 8-10 at FSLI headquarters for a Short-Term Joint Training Event. This event brought together teachers, school principals, and experts from all participating organizations.
