- Promote flexible upskilling and reskilling pathways in adult education.
- Address gaps in digital training and competence recognition across Europe.

KEY PROJECT RESULTS

Digital Competency Development Platform: A multilingual online platform that offers adult educators an accessible space to explore AI tools and digital teaching methods. The platform supports continuous professional development through interactive and practical learning resources.



AIM

DAMET aims to strengthen the digital and pedagogical competences of adult educators by supporting the effective use of AI tools and by recognising acquired skills through a European microcredential framework. DAMET delivers practical tools and resources that support digital competence development, recognition of skills, and innovation in adult education.

TARGET GROUPS

- **Main Audience:** Adult educators, trainers, adult education staff, and guidance professionals.
- **Wider Community:** Educational institutions, adult learners, policymakers, education stakeholders, private sector actors, technology providers, and research organisations.

Microcredential Framework for Digital Competences: A European framework that defines how digital and AI competences are recognised and validated. It ensures transparency, consistency, and trust in the issuing of microcredentials across partner countries.

E-learning Programme: A structured e-learning programme consisting of six short modules. Each module focuses on the practical use of AI and digital tools in real teaching situations and leads to badges that contribute to DAMET microcredentials.
